




Teaching and management software for the networked classroom






Share any screen with the class; distribute and collect work




Manage your classroom and follow students as they work

Prevent students from accessing websites or using specific applications



Distribute and collect documents from students



Test

Create and perform regular tests - 10 different question types



Use NetOp School's powerful Test Center to appraise students online. Rapidly prepare exams using the module's Wizard. Once ready, distribute a test to all students simultaneously at the touch of a button. Finally, correct and score tests automatically for convenience and speed. You can even generate electronic reports on each student's performance, enabling immediate individual feedback.



The quick, easy and accurate way to test students

NetOp School's Test Center is a simple and fun way to appraise students regularly. Tests can be quickly prepared based on one of the system's ten question types, which include multiple choice, dictation and image/text matching. Upon completion, test results are instantly generated, giving students rapid feedback.

Prepare




Containing ten default question types, the module's Wizard makes preparing exams an easy three-step process. Once you've prepared the questions, select from 13 layout styles. You are then ready to run the test online or, alternatively, print it out and distribute.

Perform

Online tests are distributed to all students simultaneously. Tests can be 'Unrestricted', allowing students to answer questions in random order, with the chance to go back and change answers. Alternatively, 'Restricted' tests force answers sequentially with no chance of going back. Time limits can be set for each question as well as for the whole test.

Review

The teacher's Test Monitor window lets you follow the progress of each student in real time. Questions can also be scored and corrected in real time. Once finished, a test report is generated, containing a class summary and details of each individual performance. This lets you give students instant feedback.



Other key features

Attention

Lock the screen, keyboard and mouse on student computers with a single command to obtain immediate attention.

Run

Launch pre-planned documents or applications on student computers remotely.

Communicate

Initiate online written or oral discussion forums. It's possible to hold multiple text discussions and save the text dialogs, and to send instant messages to the entire class in rich text format, including links to websites.

Workgroup

Create independent work groups and transfer full Teacher module functionality to appointed group leaders. The teacher retains overall control of the separate groups.

Commands

Logoff, shutdown or restart all computers with a single command.
